Increased awareness of safe practices to prevent HIV infection results in people being more careful and ultimately decreases infection rates. HIV/AIDS Awareness programs help people to become aware of the levels of care and treatment, whether they are living with HIV or caring for someone with this disease.

Every year, on 1st December, the world commemorates World AIDS Day. People around the world unite to show support for people living with and affected by HIV and to remember those who lost their lives to AIDS. Forty years since the first AIDS cases were reported, HIV still threatens the world. Today, the world is off track from delivering on the shared commitment to end AIDS by 2030 not because of a lack of knowledge or tools to beat AIDS, but because of structural inequalities that obstruct proven solutions to HIV prevention and treatment. Considering these facts our college organized AIDS awareness programme on World AIDS Day (01st December). Students and staff members of our

college organized a rally to make public aware of HIV/AIDS. The programme started on 1st December 2023 at 11.00 am in our college. NSS students and staff used handmade posters, slogans and flex to make the public aware.

The campaign was flagged off by the Principal Dr. H. N. Rede, the staff and NSS volunteers of the college. Dr. H. N. Rede, Principal, in his speech advised to students that while taking higher education, you have to set your goals and work honestly on it to get success. He also opined that one should be healthy and happy; because healthy body of youth will be helpful for our country. Vice Principal Dr. S. E. Munde also guided the students regarding AIDS and HIV disease with its reasons of spreading and treatment. Youth should be aware and keep their character good which helps to avoid this disease. There is wide publicity and campaign by the government on its level but the students, the youth as the citizens should do awareness in rural and urban area. He said HIV caused AIDS and interfered with the body's ability to fight infection. If detected early, a regular consultation and proper treatment helps in fighting infection and allows a patient to live long. 78 students actively participated in this event. Vice Principal, Dr. Thore D. V. and Prof. Lomte K. A. and Dr. Biradar S. R. took efforts to make the event successful.


A Report on Organic Farming Awareness Programme

India is a agricultural country nearly 60% of the people are engaged in agriculture. Each and every country should give importance to agriculture. In order to achieve the target due attention should be given to find out the problem faced by the cultivators and give solution to their growth and development for production and marketing. In order to generate more income and employment in rural areas, organic farming system could be practiced. In

this connection there is a need to conduct awareness campaign among the farm households.

Our college organized an Organic Farming Awareness Drive in collaboration with Dnyan Prabodhini, Harali at Harali during 12-13 February 2024. During this programme students got hands-on experience in the field of Organic farming. During the visit student gained information on techniques and microbes used in organic farming. The students also learnt about the importance of Organic farming, and its benefits. An interactive session was held at the institute to make student aware of benefits of using biofertilizers. During the session they were also taught about the production, processing, transportation and marketing for its commercial use.

The NSS Programme officer Dr. Kiran Lomte is the Co-ordinator of this awareness programme. Dr. S. E. Munde, Dr. R. U. Chochande, local 40 farmers and Principal Dr. H. N. Rede were present and given encouragement to the scheme. A total of 45 students participated in the event.



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
